Check ports in use

To check the listening ports and applications on Linux: Run any one of the following command on Linux to see open ports:

```
lsof -i -P -n | grep LISTEN
lsof -i:22 ## see a specific port such as 22 ##

sudo nmap -sTU -0 IP-address-Here

ss -tulw
```

```
netstat -tulpn | grep LISTEN (deprecated, use ss)
```
